

When you can't bring everyone together face to face, getting everyone on the same phone call or conference line is the next best thing.

The advantage of teleconferencing is its flexibility. If you don't have any video equipment, such as a webcam, a teleconference done via phone is to your advantage. Audio conferencing gives people the ability to dial directly to the conferencing bridge to join the conference call, or be added by the conference call hosts themselves.

Vonex's industry-leading Cloud-Based phone system, ONdesk boasts a conferencing capability that is affordable and robust. Be joined by up to 50 callers with a dedicated number. No expensive setup fees and clever keypad shortcuts so you can manage your meetings better.



Ease of use

Audio conferencing is a common practice so people are familiar with its usage. You can effortlessly join a conference call by dialling the same number as other participants and accept calls right at your desk.

Invisibility

No additional time required for getting ready for the call since you won't be seen. This can also be an advantage if you feel more comfortable leading a voice conversation rather than face to face.

Accessibility

Audio conference calls are available for any conferencing devices, whether it's a landline or your personal mobile phone so that you can join a conference call from anywhere.

Manageability

In case the audio conference call hasn't been scheduled, you can phone the participants and hold the meeting spontaneously – it won't require any setup or additional efforts to invite the participants and wait for the invitation to be accepted.

Keypad Shortcuts

Using the in-conference keypad shortcuts (a set of programmed conference commands accessible to the host by pressing a sequence of numbers on their telephone keypad) can help you control several aspects of your conference call. This is a handly list to keep in mind;

- *O Send the participants list
- *1 Mute your device
- *2 Unmute your device
- *7 Mute other participants
- *8 Unmute other participants
- '9 Hang up the conference

Daily Dials

Kept between 15 to 30 minutes long; team members take turns speaking. Each member talks about their any applicable progress from the previous meeting, the anticipated work until the next Daily Dial and any roadblocks or impediments, taking the opportunity to ask for help or collaborate.



Use a clear and concise agenda

If you're organising the meeting, make a habit of sending a brief rundown of the topics you'll be discussing, and ideally, set an objective.

For a daily meeting it might simply be knowing what your teams plans are for the day, this should be a top line summary from each but will give you an opportunity to spot any one that could have extra capacity.

Cutting through chatter

Setting a clear time limit for your meeting might be the most effective tool you have. A daily meeting shouldn't go for longer than a half-hour. Try nominating a meeting leader – someone who's adept at cutting through chatter and steering group discussion – is an excellent fail-safe strategy. Otherwise, practice your own gentle nudging skills

Document outcomes


